2009 Berkley Spring Slam

March 18-22: for 5th boys, 5th girls, 6th boys, 7th boys & 8th girls

March 26-29: for 3rd boys, 4th boys, 6th girls, 7th girls & 8th boys

The tournament is open to boy's grades 3-8 and girl's grades 5-8. Slots will fill quickly and will be distributed on first-come, first-serve basis. Only teams that pay the **\$225.00** registration fee and submit rosters are guaranteed slots. Schedules will be printed in early March. Each team is guaranteed three games. **Each team will play only one week.** There will be a snack bar available. The tournament will provide referees, a time keeper, a scorer, and basketballs for all games. No other basketballs will be allowed in the gym.

Eligibility

- Teams must come from a single town and recreation association. No AAU or regional teams.
- No player may play in two different grade/age divisions. Any player that has stayed back must play up to their natural grade level.
- Each team must have the same color jerseys with individual numbers.
- The coach shall have birth certificates for each player on hand as proof of eligibility.

Rules

- The tournament is pool play.
- No roster changes may be made after the first game.
- Teams must be ready to play their games at the scheduled start. No grace period is allowed.
- Five players are required to begin a game.
- Only the head coach, the assistant coach, the scorer and players are allowed on the bench.
- Only one coach may stand at a time and he/she must stay off the court while the ball is in play.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct by a coach, player or fans will not be tolerated.
- All games will be two 20-minute halves with a running clock except for the last 2 minutes of each half when it will be stopped time. No shot clock.
- Two timeouts are allowed for each team during a half. They are not carried from the first half to the second half nor are they carried into overtime.
- Bonus begins on the seventh foul in a half. Double bonus is after the 10th team foul in a half. Players foul out with five fouls. Technical fouls count as personal fouls. Coaches and players are ejected on the second technical foul. Coaches and players ejected from a game are ejected from the tournament.
- Overtime will be 3 minute periods until one team wins. One time out is granted per overtime period. Overtime will be played as the same as the last 2 minutes of the game.
- Tie-breakers are as follows: 1. Head-to-head record, 2. Least points allowed (3 game total), 3. Most points scored (3 game total) and 4. Coin toss.

Defense & Mercy Rules

- In the 3rd grade division, backcourt pressure is allowed for the final 2 minutes of the game.
- In the 4th & 5th grade divisions, pressing is allowed in the second half only.
- In the 6th, 7th and 8th grade divisions, there are no defensive restrictions.
- Presses by both teams must be canceled if a team leads by more 15 or more points. The first violation will result in a warning. Each subsequent press will result in a technical foul assessed to the head coach.

Other

The court will remain cleared during all timeouts. Only standard water bottles are allowed in the gymnasiums. No soda, sports drinks, jugs of water or coffee is allowed. Food, snacks and refreshments will be available for purchase in the lobbies of both schools. Games will not be rescheduled once the tournament begins. Trophies will be awarded to championship teams (up to 12 per team).

To Berkley Middle School:

From Rt 495 and Points North:

Take Rt 495 to Rt 24 South

Take Rt 24S to Exit 11, Padelford St.

Turn right at end of off-ramp.

Go approx. 1.1 miles to stop sign. Turn right at stop sign. Go to stop sign (across from gas station). Go straight through stop sign. Take first left into Berkley Middle School. Gym entrance is on left end of the building, parking is available in front of and behind the school.

From Rt 195 and Points South:

Take Rt 195 to Rt 24 North

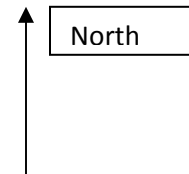
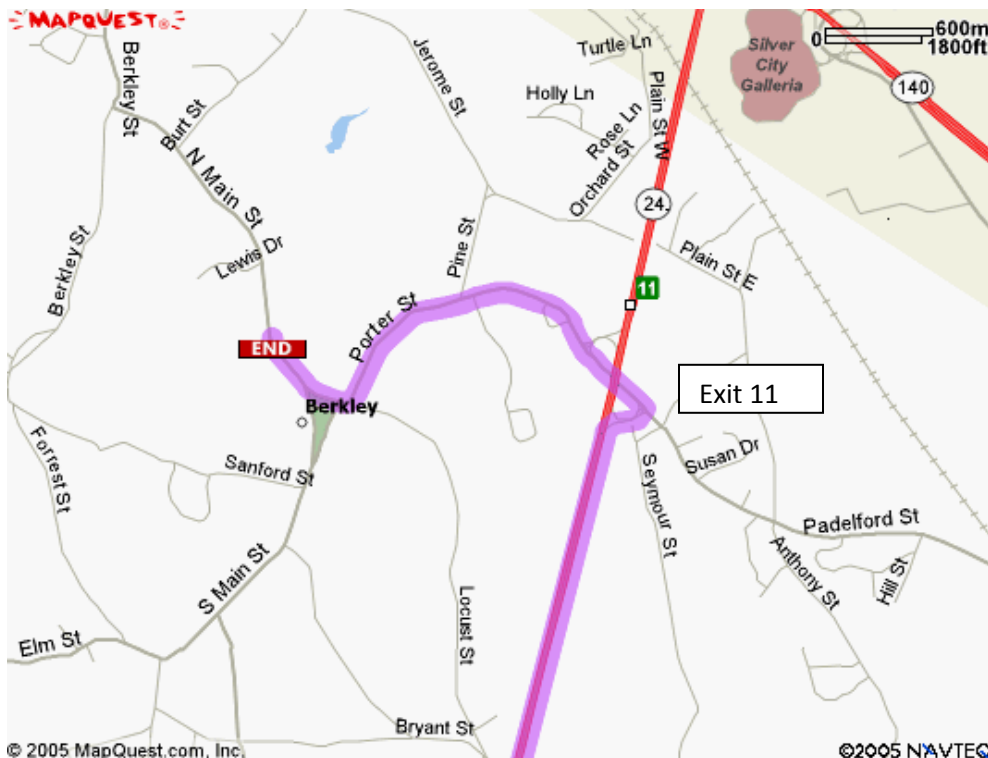
Take Rt 24N to Exit 11, Padelford St.

Turn left at end of off-ramp.

Go approx. 1.3 miles to stop sign. Turn right at stop sign. Go to stop sign (across from gas station). Go straight through stop sign. Take first left into Berkley Middle School. Gym entrance is on left end of the building, parking is available in front of and behind the school.

From Points West:

Get to intersection of Rt 138 and Center St in Dighton. At set of lights, go east on Center St, past the Bristol Agricultural High School. Continue straight over bridge. Go about 2 miles to fork in rd, bear left. Go past Police/Fire Stations. Continue about another ½ mile, school entrance is on the left. Gym entrance is on left end of the building, parking is available in front of and behind the school.



To Berkley Community School:

From Rt 495 and Points North:

Take Rt 495 to Rt 24 South

Take Rt 24S to Exit 10, North Main St.

Turn right at end of off-ramp.

Go approx. 2.5 miles; school will be on your left.

Gym entrance is on left end of the building, parking is available on both ends of building and in front of the school.

From Rt 195 and Points South:

Take Rt 195 to Rt 24 North

Take Rt 24N to Exit 10, North Main St.

Turn right at end of off-ramp.

Go approx. 2.5 miles; school will be on your left.

Gym entrance is on left end of the building, parking is available on both ends of building and in front of the school.

From Points West:

Get to intersection of Rt 138 and Center St in Dighton. At set of lights, go east on Center St, past the Bristol Agricultural High School. Continue straight over bridge. Go about 3/4 miles to South Main St. Take a right on South Main St. School will be about ¼ mile down on right.

Gym entrance is on left end of the building, parking is available on both ends of building and in front of the school.
