Berkley Spring Slam 2010

March 17-21: Boys: 4th, 6th & 7th grade; Girls 4th & 8th grade
March 24-28: Boys: 3rd, 5th & 8th grade; Girls 6th & 7th grade

The basketball tournament is open to boy's grades 3-8 and girl's grades 4 and 6-8. Slots will fill quickly and will be distributed on first-come, first-serve basis. Only teams that submit the **\$225.00** registration fee and roster 2 weeks prior to the tournament are guaranteed slots, unless already filled. Schedules will be e-mailed a week prior to the tournament to the contact's address provided. Each team is guaranteed 3 games. Each team will play only 1 week. There will be a snack bar available and 4 Celtic's tickets to the half-court shot winner over the tournament. The tournament will provide referees, a time keeper, a scorer and basketballs for all games. No other basketballs will be allowed in the gym.

Eligibility

1. Teams must come from a single town and recreation association. No AAU or regional teams.
2. No player may play in two different grade/age divisions. Any player that has stayed back must play up to their natural grade level.
3. Each team must have the same color jerseys with individual numbers. No jewelry allowed.
4. The coach shall have birth certificates for each player on hand as proof of eligibility.

Rules

1. The tournament is pool play. 3 game minimum.
2. All games will be two 16-minute halves with a running clock except for the last 2 minutes of each half when it will be stopped time. No shot clock.
3. The clock will also stop on all foul shots and time outs.
4. No roster changes may be made after the first game.
5. Teams must be ready to play their games at the scheduled start. No grace period is allowed.
6. Five players are required to begin a game.
7. Only the head coach, the assistant coach, the scorer and players are allowed on the bench.
8. Only one coach may stand at a time and he/she must stay off the court while the ball is in play.
9. Unsportsmanlike conduct by a coach, player or fans will not be tolerated.
10. Two timeouts are allowed for each team per half. No carryovers.
11. Bonus begins on the seventh foul in a half. Double bonus is after the 10th team foul in a half. Players foul out with five fouls. Technical fouls count as personal fouls. Coaches and players are ejected on the second technical foul, are out for the tournament and must leave the premises immediately.
12. Overtime will be 3 minute periods until one team wins. One time out is granted per overtime period. Overtime will be played as the same as the last 2 minutes of the game.
13. Tie-breakers are as follows: 1. Head to head record, 2. Points against, 3. Points for and 4. Coin toss.

Defense & Mercy Rules

1. In the 3rd grade division, backcourt pressure is allowed for the final 2 minutes of the game.
2. In the 4th & 5th grade divisions, pressing is allowed in the second half only.
3. In the 6th, 7th and 8th grade divisions, there are no defensive restrictions.
4. Presses by both teams must be canceled if a team leads by more 15 or more points. The first violation will result in a warning. Each subsequent press will result in a technical foul assessed to the head coach.

Other

The court will remain cleared during all timeouts. Only standard water bottles are allowed in the gymnasiums. No soda, sports drinks, jugs of water or coffee is allowed. Food, snacks and refreshments will be available for purchase and consumption in the lobbies of both schools. Games will not be rescheduled once the tournament begins. Trophies will be awarded to the championship team (up to 12 per team).
